18.1 Matters arising from meeting of 16th October, 2014.

Speed limits.

The Roads Manager informed members that the island wide review of speed limits is still ongoing.

Children crossing signage.

The Roads Manager told members that the review of signage is also ongoing island wide. A member asked if the signage at Alarm Forest could be dealt with as a matter of urgency. A member stated that all road signage in general should be erected in the appropriate places. Light at Harbour View.

A member asked for an update on the rehabilitation of the Constitution Hill Road. The Roads Manager assured the member that with the arrival of a new consignment of COLAs, resurfacing of the road can be completed and the road will re-open on schedule.

Permission to Dig near HTH School.

The Roads Manager informed members that he had applied for a road crossing (permit to dig) near the old HTH School to lay a sewage pipe which might cause some disruption to traffic. Members told him to inform the public about this in good time.

Improvements to Sandy Bay Beach Road.

The Roads Manager also informed members that the Roads Section would be undertaking works to the lower Sandy Bay Beach road such as creating passing bays and improving the camber. This will be done by two men with one machine and is being funded by the Tourism Sector.
