ELECTIONS ORDINANCE, 2009

WRIT OF ELECTION

By His Excellency Mark Capes, Esquire, Governor of St Helena

To the Returning Officer

WHEREAS by subsection (1) of section 6 of the Elections Ordinance, 2009, it is provided that, for the purposes of every general election of Members of the Legislative Council, and for the purposes of the election of Members to fill vacancies caused by death, resignation or otherwise, the Governor shall issue writs of election under the public seal, directed to the Returning Officer:

AND WHEREAS, the seat of an Elected Member has become vacant in consequence of the said Member having resigned:

NOW THEREFORE, I, Mark Capes, Governor as aforesaid, do hereby require that you cause a bye election for one Member to be held according to the following particulars:

- 1. the last day and time for the receipt of nominations shall be Wednesday, 26th February 2014 at Noon, such nominations to be delivered to you at the Castle, Jamestown by the date and time aforesaid:
- 2. a poll shall be taken, if the number of nominations is such as to require one, on, Wednesday, 12th March 2014 at the following Polling Stations:

- (a) Blue Hill Community Centre;
- (b) Half Tree Hollow Community Centre;
- (c) Harford Community Centre;
- (d) Judges Lodge, Alarm Forest;
- (e) Kingshurst Community Centre;
- (f) Levelwood Community Centre;
- (g) Jamestown Community Centre; and
- (h) Sandy Bay Community Centre;
- 3. the name of such Member, when so elected, to be certified to me, at The Castle, Jamestown, on:
- (a) Wednesday, 26th February 2014, if the election be unopposed; or
- (b) Wednesday, 12th March 2014, if a poll be taken.
