CHAPTER 71

FRENCH GOVERNMENT LANDS (VESTING) ORDINANCE

(*Ordinances 2 of 1858 and 2 of 1935*)

AN ORDINANCE TO VEST IN THE FRENCH GOVERNMENT CERTAIN LANDS IN ST. HELENA FORMING THE SITE OF THE TOMB OF NAPOLEON I AND OF THE TENEMENT OF LONGWOOD.

Commencement

[18 March 1858]

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the French Government Lands (Vesting) Ordinance.

Certain lands vested in Emperor of the French

2. All the lands respectively being the same with those more particularly described in the Schedule to this Ordinance be and the same are hereby vested in His Majesty the now Emperor of the French and his heirs for ever, as absolute owners thereof in fee simple, freed and discharged of and from all right, title, or demand of, by, or on behalf of Her Majesty the Queen of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, Her heirs or successors, or of, by or on behalf of any other person or persons whomsoever.

SCHEDULE

- 1. Napoleon's Vale with the messuage or tenement thereon, and the site of the tomb of the late Emperor Napoleon the First situated in the East Division of the Island of St. Helena, bounding formerly abutting and north on the lands belonging DAVID KAY, senior; south, on the lands formerly belonging to JOHN ROBINSON, senior; west on the lands formerly belonging to THOMAS BROOK; and east partly on the waste lands of the Crown, and partly on the lands of STEPHEN FRAZER PRITCHARD; containing in the whole thirtythree acres and fourteen poles.
- 2. All that piece or parcel of land with the messuage or tenement thereon situate at Longwood in the Island of St. Helena and called or known by the name of Longwood Old House, formerly the residence of the late Emperor Napoleon the First, together with all buildings, ways, water-courses, rights, privileges and appurtenances whatsoever to the same belonging, and a space of ground surrounding the same, demarcated by six boundary pillars and containing in the whole an area of two acres, three roods and thirty-four poles.
