# PUBLIC NOTICE

## REVISED FEES AND CHARGES

With effect from 01 September 2014, the following fees and charges are payable by a person (and his/her dependant\* and children up to 18 years of age\*\*) who:

- (i) has St Helenian status **and** is ordinarily resident in St Helena and was present in St Helena for a period exceeding six months; or
- (ii) is present in St Helena, has St Helenian status and can provide proof of contract of employment for one year on St Helena; or
- (iii) is present in St Helena in fulfillment of a contract of employment **directly** with the St Helena Government, of at least one year and approved by the Head of Human Resources for the St Helena Government; or
- (iv) is a resident of the United Kingdom who requires **emergency** medical attention. UK residents seeking medical treatment that is **not an emergency** will be required to pay the medical fees and charges applicable to visitors to the island. Emergency medical attention is defined as medical attention received on island and **does not cover medical evacuation off island**.
- (v) has St Helenian status, is ordinarily resident on Ascension Island and on leave on St Helena
