- (3) This licence does <u>not</u> allow part shipments. In case of part shipment occurring for fresh produce orders, an importer must apply for a new import licence giving new shipment details for the balance of the consignment.
- (4) The licence is issued to the importer for his/her use to import fresh plant produce covered by the licence and is not transferable.
