
In 2013 there were 21 Post Box Walks on St Helens, however 2 are currently out of bounds due to the construction of the airport.

2. Population and vital statistics

St Helena in Figures

Situated in the middle of the South Atlantic Ocean, five days travel by ship from the nearest commercial airport, St Helena is a small British Island Territory heading for a big change. At present the Island is essentially dependent on overseas aid, local sources of revenue include tourism, export of fish and remittances from overseas workers. The days of physical isolation and dependence are numbered. St Helena is facing up to irrevocable change with the impending arrival of air access, a project due for operational completion in February 2016. The project will boost the local economy, provide improved opportunities and eventually lead to financial self sustainability.

As we head into this change St Helena is focused on developing

- A vibrant economy providing opportunities for all to participate
- Effective management of the environment

whilst preserving

• A strong community and family life

Statistics on St Helena, and world wide, are used by businesses, governments and the general public for the purposes of monitoring, planning and informing decisions. This document is intended to give you a brief overview of some of the key figures relating to St Helena. The data published are the most accurate known at the time of publication, however, are subject to revisions in subsequent statistical publications.

Climate:

St Helena's climate is kept mild, equable and healthy by the south-east trade winds. Annual rainfall in the last 10 years averages 253 mm (approx. 10 inches) in Jamestown and from 500 mm (approx. 20 inches) to 1,100 mm (approx. 44 inches) in the surrounding areas. In Jamestown the maximum temperature ranged from 12°-24° and the minimum temperature ranged from 10°-19° in 2012.
