## Rupert's transformed Basil Read makes progress

The Rupert's area is currently undergoing a minor facelift as Basil Read has begun work on:

- Constructing a temporary Haul Road from the Quarry to the Shears and
- Constructing a Satellite Workshop near the Cannery

Works will also start in the coming weeks on:

- Blasting at the Quarry Site
- Moving Rock from the Quarry Site to the Temporary Jetty Site (adjacent to the Shears)
- Minor modification to the inside of the Cannery Building
- Levelling a platform for temporary fuel storage between St Michaels Church and the Power Station

Rock Blasting at the quarry on the western slope of Rupert's Valley between the Power Station and Incinerator will commence on Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> March 2012. The rock will then be transported from the Quarry to the Temporary Jetty Site. Further detailed information on the blasting operations will be announced closer to the date via both local radio stations. Residents and workers in the Rupert's area will also be contacted directly by Basil Read and Halcrow staff.

Basil Read has leased the building at which the Cannery used to operate in Rupert's and will be carrying out minor modifications to the inside to accommodate:

- a laboratory for testing concrete and soil samples and
- a dry storage area for equipment and material
