## Memorandum for Executive Council

SUBJECT	Increase in Fees and Charges: Trade Marks, Patents and Companies Registration
	Memorandum by the Chairman, Economic Development Committee
ADVICE SOUGHT	1. Council is asked to consider and advise whether the attached Companies (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations, 2018, the Trade Marks (Fees)(Amendment) Rules, 2018 and the Patents (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations should be approved and brought into force with effect from 1 May 2018.
BACKGROUND & CONSIDERATIONS	2. As part of the budget process, Directorates are required to review statutory and discretionary fees and charges in accordance with SHG's Charging Policy 2013.
	3. The Companies fees were last reviewed in 2009; and the Trade Marks and Patents fees were last reviewed in 2012.
	4. The table attached at Annex A shows current and proposed fees, along with the proposed percentage increases.
	5. Regarding the patents fees, there has been a slight change in the Patent (Registration) Ordinance following the recent Law Revision exercise. Section 4 (copied below) previously provided that the fee for registration of a patent is prescribed by Regs made by GIC. And section 10 (also copied below) provided for Rules by the Registrar to regulate procedure and also included fees for proceedings under the Ordinance. All of the current fees have been prescribed in Regulations issued by the GIC.
	6. In the revised version of the Ordinance, reference to GIC has been removed from section 4 (see below), so now it is only the Registrar

removed from section 4 (see below), so now it is only the Registrar who prescribes the fees under section 10. However, the Registrar cannot revoke a Legal Notice that was enacted by the GIC. So rather than revoking the existing Legal Notice, the following statement will be made "These fees replace the fees prescribed in LN 12 of 1989 (as amended)".

Section 4 before Law Revision:

"4. Upon such application being received, together with the documents mentioned in section 3 of this Ordinance and upon payment of such fees as may be prescribed from time to time by regulations made by the Governor in Council, the Registrar of Patents shall issue a certificate of registration."

Section 4 after Law Revision:

"4. Upon receiving an application under section 2, the documents mentioned in section 3, and payment of any prescribed fee, the Registrar of Patents must issue a certificate of registration."

Section 10 (as it currently reads. There were no significant changes in the Law Revision):

"10. The Registrar of Patents may make such general rules and do such things as he or she considers expedient, subject to this Ordinance, for regulating procedure under this Ordinance, and for prescribing the fees to be paid in respect to proceedings under it."

FINANCIAL	5. The proposed increases will generate additional revenue for

	for the year 2016/17.

The Committee endorsed the proposed increases for<br/>submission to Executive Council for approval.
