COMPANIES ORDINANCE, 2004

*COMPANIES (FEES)(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2019*

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 251 of the Companies Ordinance, 2004, the Governor in Council makes the following Regulations:

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Companies (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations, 2019, and come into force on 1 April 2019.

**Fees**

2. The First Schedule to the Companies (Fees and Forms) Regulations, 2004, is amended by revoking the table of fees and substituting the following:
