LIQUOR ORDINANCE, 1988

LIQUOR (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2019

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 43 of the Liquor Ordinance, 1988, the Governor in Council makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Liquor (Amendment) Regulations, 2019, and come into force on 1 April 2019.

Fees

2. The Second Schedule to the Liquor Regulations, 1988, is amended by revoking the table of fees and substituting the following:

“FEES		
1.	Upon application to the court for the grant, renewal, transfer, or removal of a licence; for each application	£15.65
2.	Upon an application for special order of exemption	£10.50 plus £5.20 for each occasion (after the first) included in the same application
3.	Upon the issue of a community centre licence	£47.00
4.	Upon the issue of a liquor sales licence	£104.50
5.	Upon the issue of an occasional liquor licence	£10.45
6.	Upon the issue of any other licence, including tavern, club, hotel and restaurant	£130.30”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

The purpose of these Regulations is to revise the fees payable in respect of liquor licences.
