One dark evening in New York City, two strangers meet by chance.


Over drinks, Amanda and Wendy realise they have so much in common.

### **The Fall by Louise Jensen**


**She promised not to tell. They made sure she couldn't.**

### **Eye For An Eye by M.J. Arlidge**




#### **SCOTLAND YARD**

### **The Housemaid is Watching by Freida McFadden**



I thought I'd left my darkest secrets behind. But could this quiet suburban street be the most dangerous place of all?




### **Listen To Me by Tess Gerritsen**



#### THE MIGHT OF ROME









### **The Lucky Penny by Dilly Court**


When a twist of fate calls her back to the cobbles, Flora's new life is torn apart.

### **Happy by Fearne Cotton**






### **Wake Up by Piers Morgan**



Tina Turner was the Queen of Rock 'n' Roll. In this dramatic autobiography, she tells the story of a truly remarkable life in the spotlight.







### **Five Star Stories by Tom Gates**
