AN ORDINANCE

to amend the Income Tax Ordinance 2012 to make provision for changes to the personal allowance.

Enacted by the Governor of St Helena with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of St Helena.

Short title and commencement

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Income Tax (Amendment) Ordinance 2026, and comes into force on 1 April 2026.

Amendment of the Income Tax Ordinance 2012

2. In section 10(1) of the Income Tax Ordinance 2012, for “£7,000” substitute “£7,150”.
