**A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE**

**to increase the amounts provided for the services of the financial year  
1<sup>st</sup> April 2025 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2026**

Enacted by the Governor of St Helena with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of St Helena.

**Short title**

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (2025/26) Ordinance, 2026.

**Consolidated Fund—provision for the financial year 2025/2026**

2. The Governor may cause to be issued out of the Consolidated Fund and applied to the services of the financial year commencing on 1<sup>st</sup> April 2025, a sum not exceeding £3,126,000 (Three Million, One Hundred and Twenty Six Thousand pounds), which is appropriated for the purposes and services described in Schedule I to this Ordinance. ✓

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Ordinance)*

This Ordinance increases the 2025/26 budgets approved by Legislative Council in June 2025 for the respective portfolio expenditure based on the latest available forecast.

The amount in question will be financed by a withdrawal of recurrent budget from Head 15: Safety, Security and Home Affairs of £60,000, Head 17: Treasury of £1,843,000 and Head 22: Education, Skills and Employment of £100,000; a withdrawal of capital budget from Head 15: Safety, Security and Home Affairs of £46,000, Head 19: Economic Development of £250,000 and Head 23 Health and Social Care of £137,000; and additional Revenue of £690,000.
