Can the Honourable Minister for Economic Development and Environment, Natural Resources and Planning please tell this House what is planned to encourage residents and businesses to adopt renewable energy solutions?

**The Hon Ronald Coleman:**

Can the Honourable Minister for Economic Development and Environment, Natural Resources and Planning tell this Council what role does the Private Sector Investment play in renewable energy deployment?

**The Hon Dr Corinda Essex:**

Will the Honourable Minister for Economic Development and Environment, Natural Resources and Planning tell this Council what progress has been made regarding development of key performance indicators to monitor use of renewable energy?

**The Hon Robert Midwinter:**

Will the Honourable Minister for Economic Development and Environment, Natural Resources and Planning say what Policy relating to Renewable Energy his Portfolio is currently working against, in particular what renewable energy target is expected to be achieved and by when?

**The Hon Julie Thomas:**

Will the Honourable Minister for Economic Development and Environment, Natural Resources and Planning provide an update on progress in implementing the 2016 Energy Strategy through the Renewable Energy Policy 2023 - 2030 – specifically St Helena's commitment to achieve at least 80% renewable energy – and advise on the current status and expected timelines for the Regulatory Framework and proposed Utility Services Provider license, which were reported to be with the provider in July 2025 but have not been updated since?
