PRISONS ORDINANCE, 1960

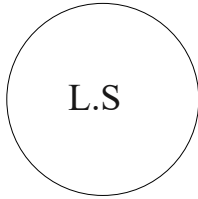
Appointment of Prison Officer

Instrument, appointing temporary Minister, Safety, Security and Home Affairs Portfolio

WHEREAS it is provided in section 37H (1) (b) of the Constitution, that whenever a Minister other than the Chief Minister is absent from St Helena or otherwise temporarily unable to discharge the functions of his or her office, the Governor, acting in accordance with the advice of the Chief Minister, may, by instrument under the public seal appoint an elected member of the Legislative Council to be a temporary Minister, and may specify the period for which such person shall perform the functions of that Minister.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 37H(1)(b) of the Constitution, I hereby appoint Derek Franklin Thomas to be a temporary Minister for the Safety, Security and Home Affairs Portfolio with effect from 12 July 2026 and until the substantive Minister for Safety, Security and Home Affairs Portfolio is able to perform the functions of that office.

CHAPTER 1

ST HELENA

Appointment of Acting Judge

WHEREAS Part 6 of Chapter 1 of the Schedule to the St Helena, Ascension and Tristan da Cunha (Constitution) Order, 2009 establishes a Supreme Court for St Helena, and section 84(1) thereof provides for the appointment of a Chief Justice and such number of other judges of the said Court as may be prescribed by law.

AND WHEREAS it is provided by section 90(2) thereof that the Governor may, acting in accordance with the recommendation of the Chief Justice, appoint such acting judge of the Supreme Court.

AND WHEREAS the Chief Justice Richard James Wright KC has recommended the appointment of His Honour Judge Oliver Saxby KC as acting Judge of the Supreme Court of St Helena for all matters incidental to the family case of 588/2025.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested in the Governor and acting in accordance with the recommendation of the Chief Justice, I, Natasha Mary Harris, Acting Governor, hereby appoint His Honour Judge Oliver Saxby KC to act as a Judge of the Supreme Court for the above named case.
