Will the Honourable Minister for Safety Security and Home Affairs advise what progress has been made by the Working Group, established following the January Advisory Board, to devise an action plan for progressing Fixed Penalty Notices (FPNs), and when the Government expects the action plan to be finalised and implemented?

The Hon Robert Midwinter:

Will the Honourable Minister for Safety Security and Home Affairs tell this Council what progress has been made towards the adoption of UK Cybercrime Legislation, as noted within the list of work that she shared with Elected Members on 28th January this year?

Will the Honourable Minister for Safety, Security and Home Affairs provide an update on the progress being made on the issues agreed towards the review and implementation of the Road Traffic Ordinance, including the anticipated timeframe for its completion?
