The Registration of Electors Regulations, 2009

PROVISIONAL REGISTER OF ELECTORS

The 2026 Register of Electors for St Helena is published in this Gazette in accordance with Regulation 3(2) of the Registration of Electors Regulations, 2009.

The Provisional Register may be inspected between the hours of 9am and 12.30pm, and 1pm and 4pm on any day (except Saturdays, Sundays and public or government holidays) at the Office of the Registration Officer, The Castle, Jamestown. Copies are also available for inspection, during the respective normal opening hours, at the following locations:

- Customer Service Centre, Jamestown;
- Public Library, Jamestown;
- ENRPP Offices, Scotland
- Sub Post Offices

A copy will be available on the SHG website: www.sainthelena.gov.sh and also at the Castle Reception.

Any person who is eligible to have his or her name included in the Register of Electors, may within 14 days from the date of this Notice, apply to the Registration Officer to have the Provisional Register amended by:

- Removing the name of the person who has died, left St Helena, or otherwise is eligible to be registered;
- Adding their name to the Register;
- Correcting any error in the details recorded (such as name or address);
- Changing the Electoral District in which they will be allowed to vote;
- Removing their name from the Register.

In addition, copies are held by the Assistant Registration Officers and at the office of the Administrator, Ascension Island.

Applications must be made in writing using the prescribed form A, copies of which are available on the SHG website, the Castle Reception, Customer Services Centre and the Public Library. Application may be delivered directly to the Registration Officer at the Castle, by 4 pm on 22 May 2026.
