### ST HELENA UTILITIES REGULATORY AUTHORITY

#### **DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5(1)(C) OF THE UTILITY SERVICES ORDINANCE, 2013**

Pursuant to section 5(1) of the Utility Services Ordinance, 2013 the Utilities Regulatory Authority hereby makes the following Directive which is effective from the **1<sup>st</sup> of July 2026**.

The maximum charges for sewerage and drainage that may be charged by the provider as set out in Gazette 62 of 2025 are amended from the 1<sup>st</sup> of July 2026 and shall be as follows:

#### **Sewerage and Drainage**

##### **Quarterly Drainage Standing Charges**

The drainage standing charges payable per quarter shall be:

Domestic	£26.36
Commercial/Government	£41.61

#### **Note:**

This amendment to the tariffs is an increase of 10% on drainage standing charges. This represents an uplift of £2.40 a quarter for domestic users and £3.78 for commercial and government users.

All other charges as set out in Gazette 62 of 2025 remain the same.
