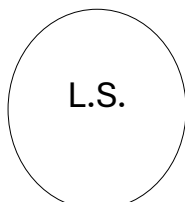

CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ORDINANCE 1999

**CUSTOMS (EXPORT AND IMPORT CONTROL) (AMENDMENT) (No.2)
REGULATIONS 2026**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 41(h) of the Customs Ordinance 1999, the Governor on the advice of the Executive Council makes the following Regulations.

Citation and Commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Export and Import Control) (Amendment) (No.2) Regulations 2026, and come into force on 14 May 2026.

Amendment of First Schedule (prohibited imports)

2. (1) The First Schedule of the Customs (Export and Import Control) Regulations 1988 is amended as follows.

(2) In paragraph 7, for subparagraph (d) substitute—

- “(d) all dairy products other than—
- (i) dairy products that have been processed using an ultra-high temperature (UHT) treatment at not less than 135°C;
 - (ii) dairy products made using milk powder and/or whey powder.”.

- (3) Omit paragraph 7A.
