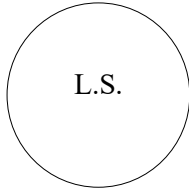

CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ORDINANCE 1999

CUSTOMS (DESIGNATION OF CUSTOMS AREAS) REGULATIONS 2026

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 41 of the Customs and Excise Ordinance 1999, the Governor on the advice of the Executive Council makes the following Regulations.

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Designation of Customs Areas) Regulations 2026 and come into force on publication.

Customs areas

2. The following areas are designated to be customs areas for the purposes of the Customs and Excise Ordinance 1999.
 - (a) Block 1, Parcels 1, 2, and 20 in the Registration Section of Jamestown;
 - (b) Block 2, Parcels 29 and 45 in the Registration Section of Jamestown;
 - (c) Block 17, Parcel 74 in the Registration Section of Jamestown;
 - (d) Parcels 5, 22, 28, 31, 32, 33, 35, 37, 47, 48, 54, 55, 56, 57, 69, 75, 82, 102, 107, 114, 116 and 117 in the Registration Section of Rupert's Valley;
 - (e) Parcels 35 and 39 in the Registration Section of Prosperous Bay.

Revocation

3. The Customs (Designation of Customs Areas) Regulations 2014 are revoked.
