CONSTITUTION OF ST HELENA, ASCENSION AND TRISTAN DA CUNHA
APPOINTMENT OF CHIEF JUSTICE

WHEREAS Part 6 of Chapter 1 of the Schedule to the St Helena, Ascension and Tristan da Cunha Constitution Order, 2009 establishes a Supreme Court for St Helena, and section 84(1) thereof provides for the appointment of a Chief Justice and such number of other judges of the said Court as may be prescribed by law.

AND WHEREAS it is provided by section 90(1)(a) thereof that the Governor, on instructions from His Majesty given through a Secretary of State, shall appoint the Chief Justice and any other judges of the Supreme Court

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested in me and acting in accordance with section 90(1)(a) and on instructions from His Majesty given through a Secretary of State, I, Nigel Phillips CBE, Governor hereby appoint Richard James Wright KC to be the Chief Justice with effect from 1 April 2026.
