AND WHEREAS it is provided by section 90(2) thereof that the Governor may, acting in accordance with the recommendation of the Chief Justice, appoint such acting judge of the Supreme Court.

AND WHEREAS the Chief Justice Rupert Trevelyan Jones has recommended the appointment of Duncan Matthew Cooke as acting Judge of the Supreme Court of St Helena.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested in me and acting in accordance with section 90(2) with the recommendation of the Chief Justice, I, Nigel Phillips CBE, Governor hereby appoint Duncan Matthew Cooke to act as a Judge of the Supreme Court for a period of five years commencing 1 April 2025.
