CURRENCY (ASCENSION) ORDINANCE, 2009

PROCLAMATION

In the Name of His Majesty Charles III, by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and His other Realms and Territories Queen, Head of the Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith.

By His Excellency Nigel Phillips CBE Governor

WHEREAS it is fitting that coins to commemorate The Coat of Arms Show Eagle designs should be issued under the provisions of section 4(1) of the Currency (Ascension) Ordinance, 2009, which said coins shall be legal tender in Ascension.

AND WHEREAS it is within the province of the Governor to specify the denomination, weight, form and design and composition of coins to be made and issued, by Proclamation and with the approval of the Secretary of State.

NOW THEREFORE, I, the Governor of Ascension, acting in accordance with the provisions of section 4(2) of the Ordinance, and with the approval of the Secretary of State, do hereby order and specify for Ascension the following coins:

Founded in 1891, the American Numismatic Association (ANA) is a congressionally chartered non- profit organisation dedicated to the study, collection and appreciation of coins, paper currency and other numismatic items.

This ANA Show Eagle design would be the first-ever legal tender coin to celebrate the rich history of both the ANA and its signature Word's Fair of Money numismatic event, which is attended by thousands of visitors each year in August.

Obverse - Features the Goddess Nomisma, the ancient Greek word for money. She is flanked by laurels, synonymous with achievement, and a chain cent and globe, representing the global bonds of numismatics.

Reverse – Features a bald eagle flying high above the Chicago skyline. The city of Chicago is not only the birthplace of the ANA, but also the host of the 2024 World's Fair of Money. The design is completed with a bust of Dr George F Heath, the founder of the ANA's monthly magazine publication.
