

IMMIGRATION ORDINANCE, 2011

IMMIGRATION (PROHIBITED AND CONTROLLED ENTRY) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2020

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 43 of the Immigration Ordinance, 2011, the Governor in Council makes the following Regulations:

Citation and interpretation

- **1.** (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Prohibited and Controlled Entry) (Amendment) Regulations, 2020.
- (2) In these Regulations, the principal Regulations mean the Immigration (Prohibited and Controlled Entry) Regulations, 2020.

Amendment of regulation 2 - Interpretation

- 2. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 2 as follows—
- (a) by revoking the words and the definition of the words "category 1 specified country or area"; and
- (b) by revoking sub-regulation (2).

Revocation of regulation 3 - Prohibited or exempted entry

3. The principal Regulations are amended by revoking regulation 3.

Revocation and substitution of regulation 4 - Controlled Entry

4. The principal Regulations are amended by revoking regulation 4 and substituting the following—

"Temporary controlled and exempted entry

- **4.** (1) Subject to sub-regulation (2) an Immigration Officer may only permit entry by aircraft or ship to a person—
 - (a) who is an Islander;
 - (b) a person who has been granted St Helenian status and a dependant of the person;
 - (c) an immigrant who was granted a long term entry permit prior to March 20th, 2020; or
 - (d) a person who is in the service of the Crown in right of the Government of St Helena and a dependant of the person.
- (2) The Governor in Council may direct the Chief Immigration Officer that a person other than a person to whom sub-regulation (1) applies is to be permitted entry.
- (3) A direction under sub-regulation (2) may be made orally or in writing and if made orally must be reduced into writing as soon as is reasonably possible thereafter and published by notice in the Gazette.".

Revocation of regulation 5 - Detention

5. The principal Regulations are amended by revoking regulation 5.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations would amend the Immigration (Prohibited and Controlled Entry) Regulations, 2020 so that entry is limited only to those persons not subject to Immigration control and persons exempted by the Governor in Council. The provisions regarding isolation and detention for non-compliance have been revoked and are now contained in the Public Health (Prevention of Formidable Diseases) Regulations, 2020.
