SOCIAL SECURITY ORDINANCE, 2010

SOCIAL SECURITY (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2020

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 17 of the Social Security Ordinance, 2010, the Governor in Council makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Social Security (Amendment) Regulations, 2020, and come into force on 3 April 2020.

Rate of basic island pension

2. Regulation 4(1) of the Social Security Regulations, 2011, is amended by deleting the amount "£74.00" and substituting "£74.30".

Household poverty level

- **3.** Regulation 7 of the Social Security Regulations, 2011, is amended—
- (a) by deleting the amount "£71.50" in paragraph (2) and substituting "£71.80"; and
- (b) by deleting the amount "£42.00" in paragraph (3)(b) and substituting "£42.05".
