

## **IMMIGRATION ORDINANCE, 2011**

# IMMIGRATION (PROHIBITED AND CONTROLLED ENTRY) (AMENDMENT NO. 2) REGULATIONS, 2020

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 43 of the Immigration Ordinance, 2011, the Governor in Council makes the following Regulations:

#### Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Prohibited and Controlled Entry) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations, 2020.

## Amendment of regulation 4 - Temporary controlled and exempted entry

- **2.** Regulation 4 of the Immigration (Prohibited and Controlled Entry) Regulations, 2020, is amended—
  - (a) by deleting the words in sub-regulation (1) preceding paragraph (a) and substituting the following:
    - "This regulation applies to persons other than—";
  - (b) by inserting the words "a person" in sub-regulation (1)(a) before the words "who is an Islander";
  - (c) by revoking sub-regulation (1)(c) and substituting the following:
    - "(c) an immigrant who has been granted a long term entry permit;";
  - (d) by inserting the following sub-regulation after sub-regulation (1):
    - "(1A) Subject to sub-regulation (2), an Immigration Officer—
    - (a) may refuse entry to a person who has failed to comply with the requirements of the Public Health (Prevention of Formidable Diseases) (Coronavirus) Regulations, 2020; and
    - (b) may revoke the entry permit of any person who fails to comply with those Regulations.
  - (e) by deleting the words "other than a person to whom sub-regulation (1) applies" in sub-regulation (2) and substituting "to whom sub-regulation (1A) applies".

# **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

The Immigration (Prohibited and Controlled Entry) Regulations, 2020, were introduced to put measures in place by which the importation of Coronavirus into St Helena could be managed. The Regulations restrict entry of travellers into St Helena and thus allowed only persons who are not subject to immigration control and persons in the service of the Crown to enter. These restrictions are being lifted and the Regulations are therefore amended to remove the restriction but enables the immigration officer to refuse a person entry and withdraw the entry permit of any person who fails to comply with the Public Health (Prevention of Formidable Diseases)(Coronavirus) Regulations, 2020.
