SOCIAL SECURITY ORDINANCE, 2010

SOCIAL SECURITY (AMENDMENT NO. 2) REGULATIONS, 2020

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 17 of the Social Security Ordinance, 2010, the Governor in Council makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Social Security (Amendment No. 2) Regulations, 2020, and come into force on 1 October 2020.

Amendment of regulation 4 - Determination of benefit

2. Regulation 4(1) of the Social Security Regulations, 2011, is amended by deleting "£74.30" and substituting "£75.50".

Amendment of regulation 7 - Household poverty line

- 3. Regulation 7 of the Social Security Regulations, 2011, is amended—
- (a) in sub-regulation (2) by deleting "£71.80" in paragraph (2) and substituting "£73.00"; and
- (b) in sub-regulation (3)(b) by deleting "£42.05" in paragraph (3)(b) and substituting "£43.00".
