Charging Policy

ADVICE SOUGHT

- 1. Members of the Education and Employment Committee are asked to review the proposed Directorate Charging Policy and give guidance on the following:
 - the use of a combined Directroate Charging Policy as opposed to separate charging policies,
 - whether the suggested fees and charges are reasonable in light of the current economic climate on St. Helena.

BACKGROUND & CONSIDERATIONS

2. In December 2012 a Directorate Charging Policy was used to guide the charging of fees for the whole of the Directorate. This was replaced in recent years by the St. Helena Community College Fee Structure and also by the Public Notice of July 2016.

The current economic climate has instigated a review of the current charges to support continued service operation within the current budget constraints and to increase revenue.

It is deemed sensible to have all of the fees and charges of the Directroate contained in one document to allow for ease of access and consistency in fees across the organisation.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3. It is anticipated that the revised fees and charges will help to support the operation of the services offered within the Directorate and to increase revenues for the benefit of St. Helena.

ECONOMIC IMPLICATIONS

4. There might be implications for users of the facilities, however there is opportunity for free and reduced rates if the users are experiencing economic hardship.
