Summary	Often windy, with the strongest winds early in the day. Low chance of an odd shower but otherwise dry, with sunny spells developing later. Patchy hill fog likely at times.
Wind	East or southeast 15-25 KT, occasionally 30 KT.
Visibility	20-40 KM.
Temperatures	Max: 21°C Min: 15°C

Saturday, 31 October 2020	
Summary	Low chance of an early shower but otherwise a dry and fine day. Quite a lot of cloud at first but sunny periods developing as the day goes on. Lighter winds than Friday.
Wind	East or southeast 12-20 KT, occasionally 25 KT.
Visibility	20-40 KM.
Temperatures	Max: 21°C Min: 15°C

Sunday, 01 November 2020	
Summary	A few light showers are possible early on but essentially it should be another dry and fine day, though relatively cloudy.
Wind	East or southeast 10-20 KT.
Visibility	20-40 KM.
Temperatures	Max: 20°C Min: 15°C
