FORESTRY ORDINANCE, CAP. 92

VARIATION OF NATIONAL FORESTS

- 1. Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of section 12 of the Forestry Ordinance, Cap. 92, that the Governor in Council is proposing to vary the Alarm Forest National Forest constituted by Statutory Rules and Orders No. 8 of 1955, so that land as described in the Schedule to this Gazette Notice may be excised from the relevant National Forest and made available to the Crown Estates Officer so as to be used for development of a new Fire Station.
- 2. Any person having any objections to the proposed variation of the said Constitution Order or wishing to make any representations in connection therewith, should submit such objection or representation, in writing, to the Chief Secretary, The Castle, Jamestown on or before 11 March 2014
- 3. According to this proposal variation shall not come into force before 22 April 2014.

SCHEDULE

Alarm Forest

1. All that area of land comprising an area of 2.0 acres located at Alarm Forest in the upper right hand corner of Parcel 365 in the Alarm Forest Registration Section, and lying on the left hand side of the main road from Gordon's Post to the Alarm Forest Police Post.

A plan of the areas concerned may be inspected at the Legal, Lands and Planning Department, Essex House, Jamestown.
