### ST HELENA

#### PUBLIC HEALTH ORDINANCE, 1939

#### ***NOTICE PROHIBITING THE LANDING AND IMPORTATION OF OSTRICH PRODUCTS ORIGINATING FROM SOUTH AFRICA***

Following the recent outbreak of avian influenza in South Africa and to prevent the introduction of disease into St Helena, I, Louise Joanne MacMorran, Acting Governor of St Helena, by virtue of section 55(1) of the Public Health Ordinance, 1939, prohibit the landing and importation into St Helena of the following products originating, produced or packaged in, or imported from, South Africa with immediate effect until further notice:

- (a) All ostrich eggs (whether fresh for consumption or fertilized for incubation);
- (b) All raw ostrich meat;
- (c) All raw ostrich offal

Take notice that under section 55(2) of the Public Health Ordinance, 1939, any person who contravenes the provisions of this notice commits an offence and is liable to prosecution.

Gazette Notice No. 101 of 18 July 2017 is withdrawn with immediate effect.

**ASCENSION****PUBLIC HEALTH ORDINANCE, 1967*****NOTICE PROHIBITING THE LANDING AND IMPORTATION OF OSTRICH PRODUCTS ORIGINATING FROM SOUTH AFRICA***

Following the recent outbreak of avian influenza in South Africa and to prevent the introduction of disease into Ascension, I, Louise Joanne MacMorran, Acting Governor of Ascension, by virtue of section 20(1) of the Public Health Ordinance, 1967, prohibit the landing and importation into Ascension of the following products originating, produced or packaged in, or imported from, South Africa with immediate effect until further notice:

- (a) All ostrich eggs (whether fresh for consumption or fertilized for incubation);
- (b) All raw ostrich meat;
- (c) All raw ostrich offal

Take notice that under section 20(2) of the Public Health Ordinance, 1967, any person who contravenes the provisions of this notice commits an offence and is liable to prosecution.

Gazette Notice No. 119 of 7 August 2017 is withdrawn with immediate effect.
