WHEREAS the public celebration of the RMS St Helena and its years of service to Ascension planned for the 3 and 4 July 2016 is an occasion of importance to Ascension.

AND WHEREAS section 5(2) of the Public Holidays Ordinance, Cap. 158, which applies to Ascension by virtue of the St Helena Law (Application) Ordinance, Cap. A1, provides that the Governor may give directions that any day which is an occasion of national importance shall be observed as a public holiday.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Lisa Phillips, Governor of Ascension, acting in accordance with section 5(2) of the Public Holidays Ordinance, Cap. 158, direct that **Monday, 4 July 2016** shall be observed as a public holiday on Ascension to celebrate that event.
