Wonderful Whale Sharks

Join Dr. Alistair Dove, Director of Research & Conservation, Georgia Aquarium at the Museum of St Helena on Tuesday 13th January at 7pm.

Whale sharks, or bone sharks as they are commonly known on St Helena, are the largest fish in the world, growing to over 18 meters and 20 tonnes. And yet, we don't know that much about them.

Dr. Dove will take us on a journey to the open ocean to explore the biology of these mysterious animals and discuss how his research with whale sharks in Mexico may help understand the recent discovery that St Helena is a globally significant whale shark hot spot.
