AN ORDINANCE

to amend the Motor Vehicle (Third Party Insurance) Ordinance, Cap. 103, to increase the minimum required amount of liability insurance for death or bodily injury.

Enacted by the Governor of St Helena with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of St Helena.

Short title and commencement

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Motor Vehicle (Third Party Insurance)(Amendment) Ordinance, 2016 and comes into force on....

Requirements in respect of policies

2. Section 4 of the Motor Vehicle (Third Party Insurance) Ordinance, Cap. 103, is amended—

- (a) by repealing item (iv) of the proviso and substituting the following therefor:
“(iv) liability in respect of one claim or a series of claims arising out of one event exceeding £250,000;”;
- (b) by repealing item (v) of the proviso.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Ordinance)

The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend the Motor Vehicle (Third Party) Ordinance, Cap. 103, to increase the minimum amount of insurance required to cover liability for death or bodily injury of any person caused by or arising out of the use on a road of a motor vehicle.
