AN ORDINANCE

to repeal the Public Dances Ordinance, Cap. 154.

Enacted by the Governor of St Helena with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of St Helena.

Citation

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Dances (Repeal) Ordinance, 2016.

Repeal of legislation

2. The Public Dances Ordinance, Cap. 154, is repealed.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Ordinance)

This Ordinance repeals the Public Dances Ordinance, Cap. 154. That Ordinance provides that no person may hold a public dance without a license which may be granted subject to certain prescribed conditions. The purpose of the license conditions was to ensure the safety at the premises, but these safeguards built into the Ordinance with respect to the structure, fire precautions, sanitary accommodation, etc are now covered by the land planning requirements. The principles contained in the Ordinance are also outdated and the Ordinance has thus become obsolete.
