





Airport Operations Team

"Whilst it was disappointing that we were unable to commence a scheduled air service to the Island in 2016, the team has remained positive and professional, taking pride in running and maintaining the complex airport infrastructure. We had planned for 52 flight operations in 2016/17 from a scheduled commercial service but this service will only commence later on in 2017. Instead in 2016/17 we supported 38 flight operations from a variety of sources.

Maintaining the standards required for consecutive airport certifications has been a key aspect of their focus, ensuring an effective aviation working environment, and providing overall operational readiness of the airport".





Distance driven by the Fire Fighting Vehicles








