Works Continue in Rupert's Human Resource Update

Works Continue in Rupert's

Construction work continues in Rupert's on the Temporary Jetty and the Temporary Fuel Storage facility .

This is only a small part of what is happening at the moment. Behind the scenes, attention is focussed on preparing final designs for the upcoming construction phases of the project (e.g. the haul road), on sourcing the correct equipment and materials, and also on recruiting staff to implement the project.

More equipment and materials arrived on the RMS on 2nd April. In a number of cases, containers were offloaded from the RMS in James Bay, transported to Ruperts by barge, and then unloaded there using the Basil Read crane. This reduces the need for haulage through Side Path and Field Road.

Work will start this month at Bradley's on the workers accommodation. The camp makes provision for housing 108 people. It will also have a fully equipped Catering Facility, Entertainment Area and Laundry Facility. These works will take approximately three months to complete. The Camp will be temporary and is only intended for use during the project. Bradley's residents have been contacted concerning this.
