WHEREAS it is provided inter alia, in Section 28 of the Constitution set out in the Schedule to the St Helena, Ascension and Tristan da Cunha Constitution Order 2009 that whenever the Governor has occasion to be absent from the seat of government for a period that he or she has reason to believe will be of short duration, the Governor may, by Instrument under the public seal, appoint any person in St Helena to be his or her Deputy during such absence and in that capacity to discharge on his or her behalf during such absence such of the functions of the office of Governor as may be specified in that Instrument:
