Instrument, appointing SUSAN O'BEY, to be Governor's Deputy.

WHEREAS it is provided inter alia, in section 28 of the Constitution set out in the Schedule to the St Helena, Ascension and Tristan da Cunha Constitution Order 2009 that whenever the Governor has occasion to visit Ascension or Tristan da Cunha the Governor may, by Instrument under the public seal, appoint any person in St Helena to be his or her Deputy during such absence and in that capacity to discharge on the Governor's behalf during such absence such of the functions of the office of Governor as may be specified in that Instrument:

AND WHEREAS Her Excellency Governor Honan will be absent from St Helena for official business on Ascension Island from 11 December 2018 - 12 December 2018

NOW THEREFORE, I Louise Joanne MacMorran, Acting Governor of St Helena hereby appoint Susan O'Bey, Chief Secretary to be the Governor's Deputy during the period of Governor Honan's absence from 11 December 2018 until her return to the island, and in that capacity to discharge on her behalf all such powers and authorities vested in the Governor (save the power of pardon) as, but no more than, she may from time to time deem to be necessary for the peace, order and good government of St Helena and Tristan da Cunha and the well being of their people.

And I charge the said Susan O'Bey that she shall, during the Governor's aforesaid absence, conform to and observe all such instructions as she may from time to time address to her for her guidance.
