BURIAL GROUNDS ORDINANCE, 1895

PROCLAMATION

Philip Rushbrook Governor By His Excellency Philip Rushbrook, Esquire, Governor of St Helena

WHEREAS it is provided in section 2 of the Burial Grounds Ordinance, 1895, that the Governor in Council may at any time by Proclamation declare any Crown land to be a cemetery;

AND WHEREAS it is required that additional burial space be made available on St Helena, due to the lack of space within the existing New Cemetery;

NOW THEREFORE I, Philip Rushbrook, Governor of St Helena, in consultation with the Executive Council and acting in accordance with section 2 of the Burial Grounds Ordinance, 1895, declare the following parcel of land as a cemetery as an extension to, and forming part of, the New Cemetery referred to in section 5(1)(a) of the Ordinance:

1. Parcel 435 of the Alarm Forest Registration Section.
