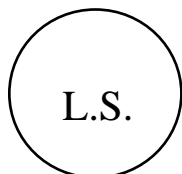

ELECTIONS ORDINANCE, 2009

WRIT OF ELECTION

To the Returning Officer

WHEREAS by section 6(1) of the Elections Ordinance, 2009, it is provided that, for the purposes of every general election of Members of the Legislative Council, and for the purposes of the election of Members to fill vacancies caused by death, resignation or otherwise, the Governor must issue writs of election under the public seal, directed to the Returning Officer:

AND WHEREAS, the seat of an Elected Member has become vacant in consequence of the Member having resigned.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Philip Rushbrook, Governor of St Helena, hereby require that you cause a bye-election for one Member to be held according to the following particulars:

1. The last day and time for the receipt of nominations is Wednesday, 13th November 2019 at Noon, such nominations to be delivered to you at the Castle, Jamestown by that date and time;
2. A poll must be taken, if the number of nominations is such as to require one, on Wednesday, 27th November, 2019 at the following Polling Stations:
 - (a) Blue Hill Community Centre;
 - (b) Half Tree Hollow Community Centre;
 - (c) Harford Community Centre;
 - (d) St Mary's Church, The Briars;
 - (e) Kingshurst Community Centre;
 - (f) Levelwood Clinic;
 - (g) Jamestown Community Centre; and
 - (h) Sandy Bay Community Centre
3. The name of the Member, when so elected, to be certified to me at The Castle, Jamestown, on:
 - (a) Wednesday, 13th November 2019, if the election is unopposed; or
 - (b) Wednesday, 27th November 2019, if a poll is taken.
