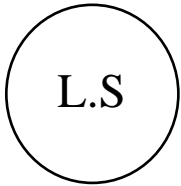

### PUBLIC HOLIDAYS ORDINANCE, 1945

---

#### PROCLAMATION

**WHEREAS** Boxing Day, the 26<sup>th</sup> day of December 2020 is observed as a public holiday under the First Schedule to the Public Holidays Ordinance, 1945.

**AND WHEREAS** 26 December 2020 falls on a Saturday and section 2(3) of that Ordinance provides that if a Public Holiday other than Christmas Day falls on a Saturday or Sunday, the Governor must, by Proclamation, direct that either the preceding Friday or the following Monday be observed as a Public Holiday *in lieu* of that Saturday or Sunday.

**NOW THEREFORE**, I, Philip Rushbrook, Governor of Ascension, acting in accordance with section 2(3) of the Public Holidays Ordinance, 1945, direct that Monday, 28 December 2020 is to be observed as a public holiday in lieu of 26 December 2020.

Given under my hand and the public Seal of St Helena at the Castle, Jamestown this 18<sup>th</sup> day of November 2019.
