BURIAL GROUNDS (AMENDMENT) BILL 2020

Memorandum by the Chairman of the Environment & Natural Resources Committee

ADVICE SOUGHT	1.	Executive Council is asked to consider and advise whether the attached Burial Grounds (Amendment) Bill 2020 (Annex A) should be printed, published and presented as Government business at the next formal meeting of the Legislative Council to be held in January 2020.
BACKGROUND & CONSIDERATIONS	2.	The Burial Grounds Ordinance was enacted in 1895.
	3.	In June 2019 a new burial ground at the Dungeon was proclaimed and it was recommended by the Environment & Natural Resources Committee that legislation concerning burials be updated.
	4.	It is proposed that the Ordinance be amended in section $9(2)(d)$ so that the approval for declarations as to the uses of a disused burial ground by the Council Committee will be obtained from the Governor in Council rather than the Secretary of State.
	5.	This is a modernization exercise and reflects that such matters should not need Secretary of State approval. The change has been agreed by the Secretary of State.
FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS	6.	There are no financial implications from enactment of this legislation.
ECONOMIC IMPLICATIONS	7.	This proposal makes more productive use of land, increasing the time necessary to source a new land plot for these purposes. In terms of SEDP objectives: Meeting Objective 5: Improve Land Productivity.

PUBLIC REACTION	12. There is likely to be majority public support since the change would mean that more graves could be accommodated on the site.
