

After your election you must submit a completed registration form to the Clerk of Councils within 7 days. After that you must register any changes or additions to your interests within 7 days.

The Register provides information about any financial interest or other material benefit which others might reasonably consider to influence what you say or do as an Elected Member. This form summarises the requirements, but it is recommend that you seek further information if in doubt.
