## **PUBLIC HEALTH ORDINANCE, 1939**

## PUBLIC HEALTH (PREVENTION OF FORMIDABLE DISEASES) (CORONAVIRUS) REGULATIONS, 2020

By virtue of the power vested by regulation 4(6) of the Public Health (Prevention of Formidable Diseases) (Coronavirus) Regulations, 2020, the Governor in Council by Order exempts the following persons, being the crew members and passenger on the MV Helena who will be entering St Helena for the day on Sunday, 13 September 2020, from the requirement for isolation under regulation 4(2), subject to the conditions set out below.

This exemption is granted subject to the following conditions:

- (a) he exempted persons are to remain within the confines of the beach area at Rupert's Bay, which area must otherwise be closed to the public;
- (b) The exempted persons are to maintain a social distance of at least two meters if they do encounter any members of the public or other persons;

- (c) The exempted persons are responsible for cleaning and sanitising all items and facilities used at Rupert's beach before returning to their vessel;
- (d) The exempted persons must collect their waste from the beach and double bag it before discarding any such waste in the public bin; and
- (e) The exempted persons must comply with all other requirements set by a proper officer.

This exemption does not otherwise affect the application of the Public Health (Prevention of Formidable Diseases) (Coronavirus) Regulations, 2020.
