Wednesday, 16 September 2020	
Summary	Some rain showers are likely in the morning, becoming less frequent (though still possible) in the afternoon. Gusty winds around the showers at times.
Wind	East 15-25 KT, easing slowly.
Visibility	30-50 KM, dropping to 4-8 KM in showers.
Temperatures	Max: 20°C Min: 13°C

Thursday, 17 September 2020	
Summary	Broadly similar to Wednesday, with showers likely in the morning but probably becoming less widespread in the afternoon.
Wind	East or southeast 10-20 KT, occasionally 25 KT.
Visibility	30-50 KM, dropping to 4-8 KM in showers.
Temperatures	Max: 19°C Min: 13°C

Friday, 18 September 2020	
Summary	Once again, showers early on, probably with hill fog for higher parts of the island, but becoming drier later on.
Wind	East or southeast 10-20 KT, occasionally 25 KT.
Visibility	30-50 KM, dropping to 4-8 KM in showers.
Temperatures	Max: 19°C Min: 14°C
