PUBLIC HEALTH ORDINANCE, 1939

PUBLIC HEALTH (PREVENTION OF FORMIDABLE DISEASES) (CORONAVIRUS NO. 2) REGULATIONS, 2020

By virtue of the power vested by regulation 4(6) of the Public Health (Prevention of Formidable Diseases) (Coronavirus No. 2) Regulations, 2020, the Governor in Council by Order exempts the following persons, being the flight crew and passengers on the flight which is expected to arrive from the United Kingdom on or around Monday, 26 October 2020, and will be transiting on the way back from Ascension on or around Tuesday, 27 October 2020, from the requirement for isolation under regulation 4(1), subject to the condition that they remain in isolation at such location as a Proper Officer directs until the departure of their flight from St Helena:
