Wind	East or southeast 15-20 KT becoming 10-15 KT.

Friday, 20 November 2020	
Summary	An odd shower is possible in the morning but otherwise it should be dry. Cloud will tend to break up, allowing sunny spells to develop later.
Wind	East or southeast 12-18 KT.
Visibility	30-50 KM.
Temperatures	Max: 22°C Min: 15°C

Saturday, 21 November 2020	
Summary	Once again, chance of a shower in the morning, but otherwise dry and bright with sunny spells developing and wind easing as the day goes on.
Wind	East or southeast 10-18 KT.

Temperatures	Max: 21°C Min: 14°C
