## **PUBLIC HEALTH ORDINANCE, 1939**

## PUBLIC HEALTH (PREVENTION OF FORMIDABLE DISEASES) (CORONAVIRUS NO. 2) REGULATIONS, 2020

By virtue of the power vested by regulation 4(6) of the Public Health (Prevention of Formidable Diseases) (Coronavirus No. 2) Regulations, 2020, the Governor in Council by Order exempts the following persons, being the crew members and one crew family member on the MV Helena, from the requirement to remain on the vessel under regulation 4(2) in order for them to access Rupert's Bay, subject to the conditions set out below.

Crew members:

Crew family member:

VAN SCHALKWYK, Denise Carol

This exemption applies with effect from 16 December 2020 until departure of the vessel from St Helena, and is granted subject to the conditions that these persons—

- (a) access the Rupert's Bay area only on the days and at times advised by a proper officer:
- (b) remain within the confines of the beach area at Rupert's Bay; and
- (c) comply with all directions and requirements set by a proper officer.

This exemption does not otherwise affect the application of the Public Health (Prevention of Formidable Diseases) (Coronavirus No. 2) Regulations, 2020.
