3. Background Information

As part of the MTEF budget process, Directorates have been asked to review statutory and discretionary fees and charges in accordance with SHG's Charging Policy, applying inflation of 2.6%.

3. Statutory fees falling under the remit of the SCDC are those for Charities Fees, Liquor Regulations and Gaming Machines Regulations. The table attached to the Memorandum shows current fees and proposed fees. Members will note that fees for Archives Research are listed in the table but as these are non-statutory they do not require any action by the Attorney Generals' Chambers. All proposed increases reflect inflation of 2.6%, with roundings to the nearest 0.05p

Current Legal Notices for statutory fees set out the current fees being applied. A Public Notice sets out the current fees applied to archives research, copy of which is on the SHG website and on display in the Archives.
